Bad actors

Intentionally misleading content lowers trust and lets us slip into our own reality.

For decades Russian bots have pushed "50/50" messaging.



Making consensus controversial and discrediting authoritative voices.

The effect is

- Distrust in institutions
- Distrust in each other
- Lower credibility of American government
- Weakened America





Media's attempt to provide coverage of both-sides, creating a false balance.



Making consensus controversial for entertainment or fear of appearing to have a left-leaning bias.

The effect is

- Distrust in institutions
- Normalizing of extremes
- Lower credibility of science and legal system







HOW TO SPOT FAKE NEWS



CONSIDER THE SOURCE

Click away from the story to investigate the site, its mission and its contact info.



CHECK THE AUTHOR

Do a quick search on the author. Are they credible? Are they real?



CHECK THE DATE

Reposting old news stories doesn't mean they're relevant to current events.



CHECK YOUR BIASES

Consider if your own beliefs could affect your judgement.



Headlines can be outrageous in an effort to get clicks. What's the whole story?



SUPPORTING SOURCES?

Click on those links. Determine if the info given actually supports the story.



IS IT A JOKE?


If it is too outlandish, it might be satire. Research the site and author to be sure.




ASK THE EXPERTS

Ask a librarian, or consult a fact-checking site.



Any Click, Any View

Your vote saying it is important

- 1. Ignore the post. Walk away.
- Only click to report it as misinformation or hate.
- 3. So mad you that you got to let it out? Leave it in the drafts.
- 4. If you must, do not click on the post. Take a screenshot and post that.
- 5. Is a friend sharing misinformation? Put an arm around them and share best practices.

When you are on social media, you are in an algorithm.

It is not real life. It is not organic.

Facebook engineers gave extra value to emoji reactions, including 'angry,' pushing more emotional and provocative content into users' news feeds



"Anger and hate is the easiest way to grow on Facebook."



How superspreaders work





Bad actors know how to use the algorithm to artificially drive and amplify content.

20 "superspreader" pro-Trump Twitter accounts were the original source of 20% of misleading narratives about voting.




Spread the truth

Repeat your words.

When introducing something new, tell it as a story. And tie it back to something familiar.

Talk to people who already know you.




Illusion of Explanatory Depth

We think we understand complex systems better than we do.

"Explain that to me"

Explaining what they think they understand will make them more humble, curious, nuanced, more moderate and less extreme.

Dunning-Kruger effect





Rebuild trust through vulnerability



The foundation of trust is vulnerability.

Trust is reciprocal.

To build trust- Be vulnerable. Create space, be curious, actively listen.

- "It scares me, there is all this information and it is hard to tell what to believe."
- "I've been fooled into believing a lie before and that hurts to realize and admit. But it is also a relief."
- "How someone voted doesn't make them a bad or good person."




